What we do know is that our innovative Integrated Care Model promises to provide personalized, patient-centered care delivered through a team-based approach for generations to come; our unique teaching partnerships will continue to inspire bright young students and enhance and enrich our care environment; and because of your support, our independent hospital system will continue to thrive.

MDI Hospital is a great healthcare organization because we have your support. We know that MDI Hospital is critical to


the vitality and wellbeing of this Island community, and we are always working to improve. Because of your support, we are a nationally recognized, outstanding rural hospital. Join me in get-

Celebrating a Half-Century of Service with a Smile

Dr. Edward B. Gilmore Retires after 46 Years

Born in Clairton, Pennsylvania in 1939, Edward B. Gilmore, MD, MACP knew he wanted to be a doctor early on. "I always had

a strong interest in science. The practice of medicine is strongly based in science, so I knew I wanted to be a doctor in junior high school after I didn't want to be a farmer or a cowboy," he says with his characteristic ear-to-ear grin and a chuckle that gently rocks his shoulders up and down. That smile is as much a part of his daily uniform as suspenders, a pair of thin-rimmed spectacles and signature bow tie—and for more than 46 years, it has instantly set his patients at ease.

A graduate of Harvard Medical School, Dr. Gilmore is a board-certified internist specializing in cardiology. After completing his resi-

dency at Massachusetts General Hospital, he knew that big city medicine was not for him. "I like one-on-one contact with patients,

seeing them in and out of the hospital," he explains. He realized then that innovation developed in large technical hospitals could be applied elsewhere to improve care across the hospital spectrum.

For nearly five decades, Dr. Gilmore has not only cared for generations of patients but has changed the face of medicine at MDI Hospital and Health Centers. An early pioneer of the Critical Care Unit (CCU), Dr. Gilmore brought the concept to MDI Hospital and built the hospital's first CCU in 1971. He was integral to the process—raising money, facilitating staff education, and even designing the unit with the help of a local contractor. Since then, the Critical Care Unit at MDI Hospital has been reborn twice, most recently in 2007 with the dedication of the Edward Gilmore Intensive Care Unit in the Colket Inpatient Care Center.

Since 1997, Dr. Gilmore has practiced at the Hospital's Cooper Gilmore Health Center, so named for him and his late friend and colleague Dr. Llewellyn Cooper. Throughout his career, Dr. Gilmore has been com-

mitted to educating the next generation of physicians, which gave him the occasion to serve as an associate professor of medicine at the University of Vermont and an adjunct assistant professor of medicine at Dartmouth Medical School. In 2013, Dr. Gilmore established the MDI Hospital-College of the Atlantic Internship Program, alongside colleague John Anderson, ecology professor and internship program coordinator at COA. The program is unique in that it allows undergraduate students to directly shadow and observe physicians and nurse practitioners across a variety of specialties and gives them the opportunity to truly immerse themselves in the clinical setting.

Beloved by his patients, students and colleagues for his warmth and kindness—and admired for his medical expertise and commitment to growth—Dr. Gilmore is always willing to share a laugh, impart knowledge or learn something new. In addition to his lifetime commitment to his patients, he is also a devoted family man. Together, he and his late wife Marsha raised three children, Kristin, Eric, and Britta, of whom he is exceedingly proud.

Dr. Gilmore is recognized as a Master of the American College of Physicians—the highest recognition available. He has been a practicing physician for more than 50 years and was recently honored by the Maine Medical Association for a half century of service. During his extensive medical career, he received the Laureate Award and the Master Teacher Award from the Maine Chapter of the American College of Physicians as well as the Advocacy for Nursing

Award from the Maine State Nursing Association. Most recently, Dr. Gilmore has worked to advance the mission of MDI Hospital as the organization's first Chief Medical Officer.

He previously served the Hospital as the President of the Medical Staff, Chief of Medicine and the Medical Director of the ICCU.

At 77, Dr. Gilmore is still as sharp as ever and plans to have an active retirement—but not before enjoying that second cup of coffee in his robe, he says with a twinkle in his eye.

Powerful Generosity Results in \$1 Million Matching Grant for Emergency Generator

Thanks to an outpouring of community and donor support for our Emergency Generator Campaign, Mount Desert Island Hospital was able to raise \$1 million to meet a challenge grant issued by The Manton Foundation of New York for a record-breaking \$1 million in matching funds—the largest foundation gift our Organization has ever received.

Many donors came together to make the Emergency Generator Campaign a success—with gifts at every range, for a combined \$1 million commitment. "We are profoundly grateful to The Manton Foundation, our Maine foundations, our local businesses and our individual donors," said Arthur J. Blank, MDI Hospital President/CEO. "These funds will serve to strengthen the health of our community and provide the capacity we need to foster growth, progress, and access to leading-edge medical technologies."

The generator campaign began in January of 2016, when The Manton Foundation offered a \$1 million challenge grant to the Hospital to replace its 35-year-old emergency generator. Because of MDI Hospital's remote coastal location, the organization needs to be particularly vigilant about protocol for natural disasters and severe weather events. "A hospital has to act a lot like a ship out at sea. We can never be out of power. The only way to do that is to have an emergency generator on standby," said Doug Springer, Director of Plant Services at the Hospital.

Once the final funding is secured, the project is anticipated to take an estimated 9 to 12 months from start to finish. There will be no interruption of emergency generator service during construction as the present unit will remain online until this project is complete. Future connections will also be accommodated to allow for expanding power needs, as well as the addition of new Hospital facilities. The organization anticipates that the new generator will come online in the summer of 2018.


Tufts Maine Track Program at MDI Hospital

Q&A with Joshua Torrey

What led you to choose the Tufts Maine Track Program and MDI Hospital?

When applying to medical school I knew I wanted to practice in a rural setting—and the Maine Track program allowed me to get

hands-on experience as a medical student in this setting. When choosing a site for my third-year, there was a lottery-type system to see which students got their top choices, and thankfully Corey and I won that lottery. I wanted MDI because I longed to be back in a small town and I knew Bar Harbor and Acadia are the most beautiful parts of Maine, so I wanted to spend nine months experiencing them.




The entire reason I chose to attend Tufts via the Maine Track program was so that I could do the Longitudinal Integrated Clerkship (LIC). The idea that we get to spend nine months following a small panel of patients through different aspects of the healthcare sys-


tem was very appealing. I want to work in a small setting after residency and have a relationship with my patients, so this experience is very important to me. Since starting at MDI, I've realized that this site is the epitome of the LIC theory; instead of seeing a small panel of patients in different hospital settings throughout the year, I've already seen many patients across the spectrum of care just due to the nature of the hospital. In that aspect, my small panel of patients has actually turned into a relatively large proportion of the patients I see, and I wouldn't have it any other way.

What have you enjoyed most about this experience so far?

One of the best things about this experience so far is the community in and around the hospital. The environment has been very welcoming, the people both helpful and caring, and the scenic views are absolutely breathtaking. Everyone I have worked with so far has gone out of their way to teach me something, give me hands-on experiences, and/or made sure that I understand what is going on. For reasons both inside and outside of the healthcare environment I am extremely happy and feel very lucky to be living and learning at MDI Hospital.



The Tufts Maine Track Program was founded in 2009 by Tufts University Medical School and Maine Medical Center. The hallmark of this program is the Longitudinal Integrated Clerkship (LIC), offering students an innovative training model that reflects a real primary-care experience. Mount Desert Island Hospital is the only institution in Hancock County invited to take part in this pioneering educational program. During their nine-month clerkship experience, Maine Track students work alongside MDI Hospital's medical staff, following cases from beginning to end in a process that is patient-oriented, rather than program-oriented. Students gain a broader and more empathetic view of healing, and learn lasting lessons in doctor-patient relationships and communication.



Q&A with Corey Lynn Johnson

What led you to choose the Tufts Maine Track Program and MDI Hospital?

I chose the Maine Track for many reasons, one of which was the unique opportunity to complete my third-year clerkships in rural Maine. I have always had an interest in primary care and so I was drawn to the prospect of learning in a small town where providers have developed sincere relationships with their patients. MDI Hospital interested me because of the size and the variation in population from season to season. I also have talked with past Tufts students who have completed the Longitudinal Integrated Clerkship (LIC) at MDI Hospital and they had so many positive things to say, I knew it was a good fit.

What are the benefits of completing your clerkship at MDI Hospital?

I am receiving a personalized education here through one-on-one time with the attending providers. This allows me to continue to build my foundation of clinical skills with lots of practice and constructive feedback. As a student interested in providing longitudinal care in the primary care setting, I am excited to already have seen a few of the same patients as they receive care from different providers. This continuity is extremely difficult to achieve under any model other than the LIC.

MDI is different than many of the other LIC sites because of the tourism in the area. I am excited to learn in a setting that is capable of providing high-quality care to a constantly changing population while

maintaining relationships with the patients who receive a majority of their care on the Island. Even though I am just starting, it is obvious the providers here are dedicated to caring for every patient and have formed genuine relationships with them; as a student that adds even more to my education.

What have you enjoyed most about this experience so far?

Every day has been different than the one before. I truly have enjoyed the variety that comes

with each change of setting. What has been consistent, from Cadillac Family Practice to the Emergency Department to the operating room, is the friendly staff and their eagerness to teach. Each day gives me further confidence I have chosen the right career path. I am excited to start every morning because I never know where the day will take me! Exploring the sights of Bar Harbor and Acadia has been fun too!


